Instructions for Giving Remedies

Always follow the suggested dosage instructions on your Product Sheet.

Drops

Drops are best given to pets into their mouth **with** several drops of water.

* We suggest to:

1. Place the required product drops for each pet into the small glass vial.
2. All drops can be mixed together at one time for each pet, unless otherwise noted.
3. Place the combined tincture from the vial directly into the dogs mouth. Simply lift the lip and pour it inside on the lip or tongue area. The tincture only needs to be absorbed through the membranes of the mouth, swallowing is not necessary.

Remember:

- One drop means **one drop** of tincture. It is **NOT** one dropper full! It is a tiny amount, but it can be potent stuff.
- Give drops 15 minutes before or after a meal to ensure that the tincture is absorbed into the body.

FYI

How long will one bottle of a remedy last?

- One 1 oz bottle of tincture = 720 drops
- One 2 oz bottle of tincture = 1440 drops

Capsules

If you are giving any capsule type remedy, it is sometimes easier to open the capsule and put it in the animals food. Sometimes, with dogs especially, and some cats, it is easy to give any powdery substance mixed in a small bowl of raw meat juice. It goes down very easy! Please adapt the contents of the capsule to your specific animal as you feel is best appropriate. You know your animal the best!
